level of US\$207.6 million for four years to address the needs. In line with the resource mobilization framework of the CP and based on availability of funding from other sources, budget revisions were approved to include on-top contributions from 2007 and 2008. The proposed budget revision includes additional on-top contributions in 2009, which are as follows:

- (i) US\$2.6 million confirmed by ECHO to assist households affected by the rodent crisis in the Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) under ACT 4.
- (ii) US\$7 million corresponding to 20,000mt of wheat confirmed from the USA unde4r the McGovern Dole initiatives to be registered under ACT 3.
- (iii) US\$5.3 million corresponding to 50,000mt of cereals donated by the Government of Bangladesh under ACT 1.

The ECHO contribution includes cash transfer of US\$1,000,000, which will be implemented as per the attached cash guidelines.

In line with the approved Country Programme, the CO requests of the budget revision. Including this revision the CP budget stands US\$247 million, which remains within the US\$309.2 million approved CP ceiling.
