#### NATURE OF THE INCREASE

The BR of the development Project has two main objectives:

- a) Provide assistance to an additional 180,000 children and mothers in three districts previously assisted through the PRRO. The new PRRO's (Jan-Dec 2011) focus is on early recovery with assistance provided to IDP in camps and recent returnees. Ministry of Health requested WFP to expand the coverage of the development project to cover the needs of children and pregnant and lactating women in the most vulnerable districts.
- b) Support the increase in production capacity of Thriposha by providing soya and maize to the production Thriposha factory.

### JUSTIFICATION FOR EXTENSION-IN-TIME AND/OR BUDGET INCREASE

## **Summary of existing project activities**

DEV project started in Jan 2008. DEV project is implemented only in 6 districts. These districts have the highest malnutrition rates. The main activities are; provide supplementary food to children under 2 years of age to reduce malnutrition;

Target supplementary feeding of children 24 months to 59 months to reduce GAM prevalence

Provide supplementary food to pregnant mothers to reduce low birth weight

Provide supplementary food to lactating mothers during the first 6 months after delivery to encourage EBF;

To build the capacity of the country to produce Fortified blended food to meet their requirement. MCHN beneficiaries prefer Thriposha and therefore the government requested WFP's assistance to purchase soya and maize to produce Thriposha. Therefore, WFP will no longer be purchasing or importing CSB.
