NATURE OF REVISION:

The budget revision is proposed

- increase the tonnage of commodities by 23,880 MT to absorb the funds already received from USA and Japan and any other contributions in future,
- adjust the commodity costs of wheat flour, vegetable oil,
- adjust the associated cost (LTSH, ODOC, DSC)
- extension in time from 30 Sep to 31 Dec 2009

JUSTIFICATION FOR THE REVISION:

The Governments of the USA and Japan had contributed around US\$ 37 million for EMOP 10768.0 which was used to procure wheat, vegetable oil and fortified blended food. While the prices of wheat and vegetable oil have gone down over a period of time, it has been estimated that the remaining un programmed contribution could be used to procure more food

than originally planned. The additional food to be procured would be sufficient to feed the targeted beneficiaries of the safety-net and school feeding programmes for another quarter. This would require extension in time and adjustment of the associated cost including ODOC, LTSH and DSC in order to consume the additional commodities during the extended period.

The external transport will be adjusted accordingly because bulk of the commodity will be procured locally which would require additional cost for internal transportation.
