## NATURE OF ADJUSTMENT:

1. Provide details about the budget revision and describe the impact on the project budget.

This Budget Revision refers an extension in time by one month (to 31 July 2010) without any increase or decrease of the existing approved budget (no-cost extension).

## JUSTIFCATION FOR THE ADJUSTMENT:

2. Provide brief background of the operation/project/programme, including the objectives of components or activities.

The overall goal of the EMOP 107880 is to complement the Government safety programmes and to alleviate the impact of high food prices in highly food insecure and disaster prone areas. The EMOP activities include:

- Targeted Relief Assistance to meet food needs of vulnerable groups in high food insecure rural and urban areas;
- Nutrition Interventions to reduce and/or stabilize acute malnutrition among vulnerable groups in worst affected areas;
- Emergency School Feeding to improve enrolment, attendance and learning in primary schools in remote rural areas;
- Employment Generation to improve access to food through income transfer in-kind or cash with particular emphasis on disaster risks reduction activities; and
- Capacity building to strengthen the capacity of the Government of Bangladesh to design and implement effective safety nets.
- 3. Describe reasons for extension/reduction-in-time (e.g. difficulties the project/ programme has encountered).

The Country Office proposes a one moth no-cost extension of the EMOP 107880 until 31 July 2010 for the following reasons:

- The distribution of cash grant to 25,000 households in ongoing, which is closely being monitored by WFP to ensure that the cash grants are used by the households to buy the intended assets. This extension will allow WFP to undertake distribution with appropriate level of monitoring, through household visits and to determine the efficiency on the use of the cash grant. This was strongly recommended by the last EC Monitoring mission conducted in December 2009.
- The implementation of all physical work (accomplished through Food/Cash for Work) is also ongoing. The final payment is contingent upon the measurements which are taken by the relevant Government technical agencies. The extension is requested to ensure WFP's close review and monitoring of the physical work accomplished.

In general, this extension is requested to allow WFP an additional month to finalize the distributions, with an adequate level of monitoring and to ensure that payments are based on the actual work accomplished as measured by the Government technical agencies.
