## NATURE OF THE DECREASE

- 1. PRRO 200540 which commenced on the 01 July 2013, carried over 55, 000 mt of food from two previous programmes: PRRO 200167 and EMOP 200480. The resource transfer from the two operations resulted in a resource transfer shortfall amounting to \$US 12 million.
- 2. The surge in violence in North Kivu coincided with the harvest period as well as the subsequent planting seasons. Rapid assessments conducted indicated high rates of food insecurity, especially amongst Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs), whose livelihoods have been significantly disrupted.
- 3. Given the sharp deterioration of the humanitarian situation and the resulting need to implement lifesaving distributions to IDPs the LTSH shortfall was fully offset with a SRAC allocation of US\$4.9 million and an IRA advance of \$US 7.9 million.
- 4. This budget revision seeks to revise the LTSH matrix through:
  - A reduction in the LTSH rate (which was increased in budget revision one to factor in part of the shortfall); and
  - Account for the increased rate in transport costs in Rwanda from November 2013.
- 5. This budget revision will decrease the "Food and related costs component" by USD3,593,094. This will result in an overall budget decrease from USD477,941,228 to USD474, 096, 617.
